

## I. GENERAL INFORMATION

Title: WTKU European Traditional Karate-Do Championships 2023

Sanctioned by: World Traditional Karate-Do Union (WTKU)

**Date:** 5 - 7 October, 2023

# II. PARTICIPANTS

All athletes that are selected by the respective WTKU member National Federations to compete must fulfil the following conditions:

Each WTKU member international organization and representative national federation has the right to send their own competitors to each category.

- 1. In cadets and juniors categories competitors must have brown belt, issued by national federation or registered black belt (Shodan or higher).
  - Brown belts are ONLY allowed for cadets and juniors. In order to compete in youth and senior groups black belt is required.
- 2. Age in agreement with their competition category.
- 3. Competitors must know, fully understand and be able to compete in accordance with the WTKU competition rules.
- 4. Competitors must be free of any physical or mental handicap that might cause a breach of the WTKU rules.
- 5. KUMITE (KO-GO and JIYU) and FUKU-GO athletes are obliged to have mouth (teeth) guards (breast-protection for women, groin protector for men are optional, but recommended safety equipment).
- 6. Competitors must have his/her own <u>international traveling insurance</u> and also <u>personal accident insurance</u> issued by their respective national federations.
- 7. Competitors must present Medical Release and international health insurance to medical emergencies.

## V. APPLICATIONS & REGISTRATION

#### A. Registration

All registrations are to be done ONLINE. We will provide the link on 15<sup>th</sup> of September, 2023. For proper registration all application forms MUST include:

- 1. Details of all officials, coaches, judges, photographers.
- 2. Details of all athletes including respective competing categories.
- 3. <u>Deadline!!!</u> All registrations must be done <u>by September 30<sup>th</sup> 2023</u>.

### **Important Notes:**

Any application sent after the deadline above shall still be processed, however with double athlete participation fees applied.

### **B.** Participation Fee

All fees must be paid **only via bank transfer until 2<sup>nd</sup> of October 2023**. Based on your payment we will issue an invoice.

#### **Athletes**

**60 EUR per athlete** (single fee per athlete. Athlete can participate in all respective individual categories).

60 EUR per team



#### **Coaches**

One official coach per 10 athletes from 1 team is free of charge.

For each additional coach the respective national delegation is obliged to pay 50 EUR registration.

Only registered coaches shall be allowed on the competition floor.

### **Photographer**

One photographer per team is free of charge.

Extra photographer will be charged for 50 EUR.

Only registered photographer shall be allowed on the competition floor.

## VI. JUDGES

- 1. Selection of the Judges will be made during the WTKU Judges' Refresher Course held right before the European Championships.
- 2. Each judge candidate must submit the online registration by **September 30<sup>th</sup>**, **2023**.
- 3. All Judges must bring their own HAKAMA (black), whistle and clean KARATE-GI including white KARATE-GI top.
